PESACH 6 *The ancient sages of Israel interpreted Lev 23:15 as the Jewish people are obligated to count the days from the 2nd night of Passover to the day before Shavu'ot (a period of 7 full weeks). This period > 20 Nisan — *Omer 5	PESACH 7  is known as the Counting of the Omer. An omer is a unit of measure. When the Temple was standing, an omer of barley was harvested on the 2nd day of Passover (commemorating the Exodus) and Shavu'ot → 21 Nisan — *Omer 6	PESACH 8 (commemorating the giving of the Torah on Mt.
