**Parasha Reading:**

Parasha is a portion of Scripture.

It is believed that during the time of the Prophet Ezra, the Torah was divided into weekly readings. There are 54 weekly readings plus special holy day readings. They have continued until today.

By Simchat Torah, the Torah is concluded; reading cycle begins again the following Shabbat.
