This period →</p>	<p><b>PESACH 7</b></p> <p>is known as the Counting of the Omer. An omer is a unit of measure. When the Temple was standing, an omer of barley was harvested on the 2nd day of Passover (commemorating the Exodus) and Shavu'ot →</p>	<p><b>PESACH 8</b></p> <p>(commemorating the giving of the Torah on Mt. Sinai).
