Parasha Reading:

Parasha is a portion of Scripture. It is believed that during the time of the Prophet Ezra, the Torah was divided into weekly readings. There are 54 weekly readings plus special holy day readings. They have continued until today. During synagogue services, Yeshua and the apostles participated in the weekly readings.

By Simchat Torah* (in English: *Rejoicing in the Torah*), the Torah reading cycle is concluded; the cycle begins again the following Shabbat.

Num 28:26</p>	<p>Counting the Omer (Lev 23:15-16) Omer/sheaf is a unit of measure Everyday from Bikurim or First Fruits (the 2nd day after erev Passover) through the day before Shavuot, an omer of barley is counted (called Counting the Omer). Daily the omer sacrifice was taken to the Temple.
