## NOTES from Pastor Cole's message

### Salvation: Justification and Sanctification

The 1<sup>st</sup> step is Justification. Through faith we are justified. This is a one-time act when God declares an individual righteous/justified and past sins are forgiven when we ask for forgiveness.

Romans 5:8-10: "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him. For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life."

Note: the Torah does not save us. It guides us in how to walk day-by-day in sanctification. (Ro 5:8-10, 3:21-26, 6:11-16; 1Jn 3:4)

The 2<sup>nd</sup> step is Sanctification. We are not perfect, but we are set apart for His purposes. Daily, we must grow in the likeness of Him. We do not do this *in order* to be saved, but *because* we are saved we do these things.

We are to walk in Cod's constitution – the Torah.

John 15:9-10: "Now remain in My love. If you obey My commands, you will remain in My love, just as I have obeyed My Father's commands and remain in His love."

Sanctification is walking in that which YHVH has sanctioned.

What we think about all day is what we become. We need to guard our minds by filling our thoughts with His Word.

**EXPLANATION OF LITURGY & TORAH SERVICE**

- 1 When reciting the Shema face East toward Jerusalem, following the Prophet Daniel's example of praying facing toward the Temple
  - 2 Yeshua declared the Shema is the greatest Commandment, Mk 12:29 & Dt 6:4
  - 3 Love your neighbor as yourself, Mk 12:30-31; Lev 19:18; Dt 6:5-9
  - 4 **The purpose of the Torah Service is to reverence God's Holy Word**
  - 5 As YHVH told Joshua: “Be strong and of good courage” Joshua 1:6.
  - 6 Holding up the Scroll allows everyone the opportunity to see what was just read
  - 7 Parading the Torah allows everyone to honor God's Word
- \* The tetragrammaton יהוה is pronounced in various ways: Adonai, HaShem, Yahweh. At CFS, we pronounce His personal name as Yahveh, how many scholars believe it was pronounced during the time of our Messiah.
