Hear, O Israel, YHVH* Our God, YHVH* is One.

Blessed be His glorious Name Whose kingdom is forever and ever!

And you shall love YHVH* your God with all your heart & with all your soul & with all your might.

And these words that I command you today shall be in your heart.

And you shall teach them diligently to your children, & you shall speak of them when you sit at home, & when you walk along the way, & when you lie down & when you rise up.

And you shall bind them as a sign on your hand, & they shall be for frontlets between your eyes.

And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house & on your gates. (Dt 6:4-9, ESV)

And you shall love your neighbor as yourself. Amen. (Lev 19:18b, ESV)

----- EXPLANATION OF TERMINOLOGY -----

¹ When reciting the Shema, face East toward Jerusalem, following the Prophet Daniel's example of praying facing toward the Temple

² Yeshua declared the Shema is the greatest Commandment, Mk 12:29 & Dt 6:4

³ Love your neighbor as yourself, Mk 12:30-31; Lev 19:18; Dt 6:5-9

* The tetragrammaton יהוה is pronounced in various ways: Adonai, HaShem, Yahweh. At CFS, we pronounce His personal name as Yahveh, as many scholars believe it was pronounced during the time of our Messiah.
