- ¹ When reciting the Shema face East toward Jerusalem, following the Prophet Daniel's example of praying facing toward the Temple
- ² Yeshua declared the Shema is the greatest Commandment, Mk 12:29 & Dt 6:4
- ³ Love your neighbor as yourself, Mk 12:30-31; Lev 19:18; Dt 6:5-9
- ⁴ The purpose of the Torah Service is to reverence God's Holy Word
- ⁵ As YHVH told Joshua: "Be strong and of good courage" Joshua 1:6.
- ⁶ Holding up the Scroll allows everyone the opportunity to see what was just read
- 7 Parading the Torah allows everyone to honor God's Word
- *The tetragrammaton הוה is pronounced in various ways: Adonai, HaShem, etc. Many scholars believe that during the time of our Messiah His personal name was pronounced Yahveh.
