¹ When reciting the Shema face East toward Jerusalem, following the Prophet Daniel's example of praying facing toward the Temple

² Yeshua declared the Shema is the greatest Commandment, Mk 12:29 & Dt 6:4

³ Love your neighbor as yourself, Mk 12:30-31; Lev 19:18; Dt 6:5-9

⁴ The purpose of the Torah Service is to reverence God's Holy Word

⁵ As YHVH told Joshua: "Be strong and of good courage" Joshua 1:6.

⁶ Holding up the Scroll allows everyone the opportunity to see what was just read

⁷ Parading the Torah allows everyone to honor God's Word

*The tetragrammaton יהוה is pronounced in various ways: Adonai, HaShem, etc. Many scholars believe that during the time of our Messiah His personal name was pronounced Yahveh.
