firstborn; hence, chief -- eldest (son), firstborn(-ling).

males

zakar (zaw-kawr')

remembered, i.e. a male (of man or animals, as being the most noteworthy sex) -- him, male, man(child, -kind).

that come yalad (yaw-lad') to bear young; causatively, to beget; medically, to act as midwife; specifically, to show lineage

of thy herd baqar (baw-kawr') beef cattle or an animal of the ox family of either gender (as used for plowing); collectively, a herd -- beeve, bull (+ ock), + calf, + cow, great (cattle), + heifer, herd, kine, ox. and of thy flock tso'n (tsone) from an unused root meaning to migrate; a collective name for a flock (of sheep or goats); also figuratively (of men) thou shalt sanctify qadash (kaw-dash') to be (causatively, make, pronounce or observe as) clean (ceremonially or morally) unto the LORD Yhovah (yeh-ho-vaw') (the) self-Existent or Eternal; Jehovah, Jewish national name of God -- Jehovah, the Lord.
