----- EXPLANATION OF LITURGY & TORAH SERVICE -----

- <sup>1</sup> When reciting the Shema face East toward Jerusalem, following the Prophet Daniel's example of praying facing toward the Temple.
  - <sup>2</sup> Yeshua declared the Shema is the greatest Commandment, Mark 12:29 & Deut 6:4.
  - <sup>3</sup> Love your neighbor as yourself, Mark 12:30-31; Lev 19:18; Deut 6:5-9.
  - <sup>4</sup> The purpose of the Torah Service is to reverence God's Holy Word
  - <sup>5</sup> As YHVH told Joshua: "Be strong and of good courage" Joshua 1:6.
  - <sup>6</sup> Holding up the Scroll allows everyone the opportunity to see what was just read.
  - <sup>7</sup> Parading the Torah allows everyone to honor God's Word.
- \* We have chosen to say His Name Yahveh in accordance with the way many scholars pronounce the tetragrammaton יהוה as either Yahveh or Yahweh.
