----- EXPLANATION OF LITURGY & TORAH SERVICE -----

- ¹ When reciting the Shema face East toward Jerusalem, following the Prophet Daniel's example of praying facing toward the Temple.
 - ² Yeshua declared the Shema is the greatest Commandment, Mk 12:29 & Dt 6:4.
 - ³ Love your neighbor as yourself, Mk 12:30-31; Lev 19:18; Dt 6:5-9.
 - ⁴ The purpose of the Torah Service is to reverence God's Holy Word.
 - ⁵ Holding up the Scroll allows everyone the opportunity to see what was just read.
 - ⁶ As YHVH told Joshua: “Be strong and of good courage” Joshua 1:6.
- * We have chosen to say His Name Yahveh in accordance with the pronunciation of the tetragrammaton יהוה by many scholars who say either Yahveh or Yahweh.
