EXPLANATION OF LITURGY & TORAH SERVICE

- 1 When reciting the Shema face East toward Jerusalem, following the Prophet Daniel's example of praying facing toward the Temple.
2 Yeshua declared the Shema is the greatest Commandment, Mk 12:29 & Dt 6:4.
3 Love your neighbor as yourself, Mk 12:30-31; Lev 19:18; Dt 6:5-9.
4 The purpose of the Torah Service is to reverence God's Holy Word.
5 Holding up the Scroll allows everyone the opportunity to see what was just read.
6 As YHVH told Joshua: "Be strong and of good courage" Joshua 1:6.
\* We have chosen to say His Name Yahveh in accordance with the pronunciation of the tetragrammaton יהוה by many scholars who say either Yahveh or Yahweh.

Shema (Confession of a believer's faith)

שמע ישראל יהוה אלהינו יהוה אחד

Shema Yisra'el YHVH\* Ehlohaynu YHVH echad!

ברוך שם כבוד שם כבוד מלכותו לעולם ועד

(chant the line in undertone) Baruch shem kavod, shem kavod, malchuto layohlam va-ed

ואהבת את יהוה אלהיך בכל לבבך ובכל נפשך ובכל מאודך

Vayahavta et YHVH\* elohhaycha baychol lay-va-veh-cha uvchol nafshaycha uvchol mayoday-cha. (repeat twice)

ואהבת לרעהך כמוך: אמן

Ve-ahavta lere-acha kamocho. Amen

Hear, O Israel, YHVH\* Our God, YHVH is One. Blessed be His glorious Name Whose kingdom is forever and ever! And you shall love YHVH your God with all your heart & with all your soul and with all your might. And these words that I command you today shall be in your heart. And you shall teach them diligently to your children, and you shall speak of them when you sit at home, and when you walk along the way, and when you lie down and when you rise up. And you shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be for frontlets between your eyes. And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.
