Shema (Confession of a believer's faith)

Hebrew text for Shema prayer: שמע ישראל יהוה אלהינו יהוה אחד. Baruch shem kavod malchuto layohlam va-ed. Vayahavta et YHVH* elohhaycha baychol lay-va-veh-cha uvchol nafshaycha uvchol mayoday-cha. (repeat twice) Ve-ahavta lere-acha kamocho. Amen

Hear, O Israel, YHVH* Our God, YHVH is One. Blessed be His glorious Name Whose kingdom is forever and ever! And you shall love YHVH your God with all your heart & with all your soul and with all your might. And these words that I command you today shall be in your heart. And you shall teach them diligently to your children, and you shall speak of them when you sit at home, and when you walk along the way, and when you lie down and when you rise up. And you shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be for frontlets between your eyes. And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates. (Dt 6:4-9, ESV) And you shall love your neighbor as yourself. Amen (Lev 19:18b, ESV)
