- ¹ When reciting the Shema face East toward Jerusalem, following the Prophet Daniel's example of praying facing toward the Temple.
 - ² Yeshua declared the Shema is the greatest Commandment, Mk 12:29 & Dt 6:4.
 - ³ Love your neighbor as yourself, Mk 12:30-31; Lev 19:18; Dt 6:5-9.
 - ⁴ The purpose of the Torah Service is to reverence God's Holy Word.
 - ⁵ Holding up the Scroll allows everyone the opportunity to see what was just read.
 - ⁶ As YHVH told Joshua: "Be strong and of good courage" Joshua 1:6.
- *We have chosen to say His Name, the tetragrammaton יהוה, as Yahveh in accordance with many scholars who say either Yahveh or Yahweh.

AS: (Apostolic Scriptures) Lk 2:22-24; John 6:25-35, 19:31-37; 1Cor 10:1-13

Bo is the 15th in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 6,149 Hebrew letters, 1,655 Hebrew words, 106 verses, & can occupy about 207 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in January or early February. Parts are read at Passover. (Because each Scroll is the exact same, we know that no letters have been added nor subtracted.)
