What is the meaning of

"Congregation Faithful Stewardship"?

ַנְאַמָנים: מָנָאַמָנים:

"We are a unified body of Believers who is bearing witness while the Master is away."

(Adat HaArisim HaNe'amaneem)

Meanings of individual words:

Adat (pronounced: ay-daht). 기가, means 'people with unity; bearing witness.' (This term is in the TaNaKh/OT & in Mishnaic Hebrew)

<u>HaArisim</u> (ha-ah-ree-seem) קַאֲׂרָסָים, means 'in charge while the master is away.'

<u>HaNe'amaneem</u> (ha-nay-ah-mah-neem) אֲלֶגְיִם:נֶּהָ, means 'Believers.'
