In 1775, before America was even a nation, the Colonies had to fight the world's most powerful military, the British. The Colonies had no money; each person had to purchase their own uniform. It has been said that Gen. George Washington personally funded & commissioned 6 ships so the Colonies might have a presence. During that time, it was critical for each ship to fly their country's flag so other ship's would know which ships were their own. However, the Colonies did not yet have a flag. Washington's choice was a simple flag with a lone pine tree and the words "An Appeal to Heaven."
