NIV ²⁸Jacob lived in Egypt seventeen years, and the years of his life were a hundred and forty-seven.

ERV ²⁸And Jacob lived in the land of Egypt seventeen years: so the days of Jacob, the years of his life, were an hundred forty and seven years. (English Revised Version)

NASB ²⁸Jacob lived in the land of Egypt seventeen years; so the length of Jacob's life was one hundred and forty-seven years. (New American Standard Bible)
