Mishpatim is the 18th in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 5,313 Hebrew letters, 1,462 Hebrew words, 118 verses, & can occupy about 185 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in February, or, rarely, in late January. Parts are read at Passover.

(Because each Scroll is the exact same, we know that no letters have been added nor subtracted.)
