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Ki Tissa is the 21st in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 7,424 Hebrew letters, 2,002 Hebrew words, 139 verses, & can occupy about 245 lines in a Torah Scroll It is read in February or March. Parts are read during Passover & Sukkot.

(Because each Scroll is the exact same, we know that no letters have been added nor subtracted.)
