Vayak'hel is the 22nd in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 6,181 Hebrew letters, 1,558 Hebrew words, 122 verses, & can occupy about 211 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in March February, or, rarely, in late February.

Because each Scroll is the exact same, we know that no letters have been added nor subtracted.)

P'kudei is the 23rd in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 4,432 Hebrew letters, 1,182 Hebrew words, 92 verses, & can occupy about 159 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in March.
