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Tazria is the 27th in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 3,667 Hebrew letters, 1,010 Hebrew words, 67 verses, & can occupy about 128 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in April, or, rarely in late March or early May.

M'tzora is the 28th in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 4,697 Hebrew letters, 1,274 Hebrew words, 90 verses, & can occupy about 159 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in April or, rarely, in early May.

(Because each Scroll is the exact same, we know that no letters have been added nor subtracted.)
