Acharei Mot is the 29th in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 4,294 Hebrew letters, 1,170 Hebrew words, 80 verses, & can occupy about 154 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in March or early April.

K'doshim is the 30th in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 3,229 Hebrew letters, 868 Hebrew words, 64 verses, & can occupy about 109 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in late April or May.

(Because each Scroll is the exact same, we know that no letters have been added nor subtracted.)
