B'har is the 32nd in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 2,817 Hebrew letters, 737 Hebrew words, and 57 verses, and can occupy about 99 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in May.

& B'chukkotai is the 33rd in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 3,992 Hebrew letters, 1,013 Hebrew words, and 78 verses, and can occupy about 131 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in May or early June.

(Because each Scroll is the exact same, we know that no letters have been added nor subtracted.)
