- <sup>3</sup> Love your neighbor as yourself, Mk 12:30-31; Lev 19:18; Dt 6:5-9.
- <sup>4</sup> The purpose of the Torah Service is to reverence God's Holy Word.
- <sup>5</sup> Holding up the Scroll allows everyone the opportunity to see what was just read.
- <sup>6</sup> As YHVH told Joshua: "Be strong and of good courage" Joshua 1:6.

Naso is the 35th in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 8,632 Hebrew letters, 2,264 Hebrew words, and 176 verses, and can occupy about 311 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in late May or June. Parts are read at Hanukkah.

(Because each Scroll is the exact same, we know no letters have been added nor subtracted.)
