Shoftim is the 48th in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 5,590 Hebrew letters, 1,523 Hebrew words, and 97 verses, and can occupy about 192 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in August or September.

(Because each Scroll is the exact same, we know no letters have been added nor subtracted.)
