Deuteronomy 26:1

NIV ¹ When you have entered the land the LORD [YHVH] your God is giving you as an inheritance and have taken possession of it and settled in it,

NASB ¹ "Then it shall be, when you enter the land which the LORD [YHVH] your God gives you as an inheritance, and you possess it and live in it, (New American Standard Bible)

NKJV ¹ "And it shall be, when you come into the land which the LORD [YHVH] your God is giving you as an inheritance, and you possess it and dwell in it, (New King James Version)

ESV ¹ "When you come into the land that the LORD [YHVH] your God is giving you for an inheritance and have taken possession of it and live in it, (English Standard Version)

NIV ² take some of the firstfruits of all that you produce from the soil of the land the LORD [YHVH] your God is giving you and put them in a basket. Then go to the place the LORD [YHVH] your God will choose as a dwelling for his Name

NASB ² that you shall take some of the first of all the produce of the ground which you bring in from your land that the LORD [YHVH] your God gives you, and you shall put it in a basket and go to the place where the LORD [YHVH] your God chooses to establish His name. (New American Standard Bible)

NKJV ² that you shall take some of the first of all the produce of the ground, which you shall bring from your land that the LORD [YHVH] your God is giving you, and put *it* in a basket and go to the place where the LORD [YHVH] your God chooses to make His name abide. (New King James Version)

ESV ² you shall take some of the first of all the fruit of the ground, which you harvest from your land that the LORD [YHVH] your God is giving you, and you shall put it in a basket, and you shall go to the place that the LORD [YHVH] your God will choose, to make his name to dwell there. (English Standard Version)
