Ha'azinu is the 53rd in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 2,326 Hebrew letters, 614 Hebrew words, and 52 verses, and can occupy about 92 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in September or October.

(Because each Scroll is the exact same, we know no letters have been added nor subtracted.)
