Hayyei-Sarah is the 5th in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 5,314 Hebrew letters, 1,402 Hebrew words, 105 verses, and can occupy about 171 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in November, or, rarely in late October.

(Because each Scroll is the exact same, we know that no letters have been added nor subtracted).
