Vayelekh is the 52st in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 2,123 Hebrew letters, 553 Hebrew words, and 30 verses, and can occupy about 72 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in September or early October (or rarely, in late August). Vayelekh is sometimes combined with the previous parashah, Nitzavim, to help achieve the number of weekly readings needed.

(Because each Scroll is the exact same, we know no letters have been added nor subtracted.)
