Vayigash is the 11th in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 5,680 Hebrew letters, 1,480 Hebrew words, 106 verses, and can occupy about 178 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in December or early January.

(Because each Scroll is the exact same, we know that no letters have been added nor subtracted).
