Sh'mot is the 13th in the annual cycle of Torah readings. It has 6,762 Hebrew letters, 1,763 Hebrew words, 124 verses, and can occupy about 215 lines in a Torah Scroll. It is read in late December or in January.

(Because each Scroll is the exact same, we know that no letters have been added nor subtracted).
