What Does It Mean To Be A Messianic Disciple? (ie, to be Torah observant)

Matt 28:18-20 ESV:

- 18 And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.
- ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all nations...,
- teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

To accurately interrupt the Word, we must have a literal, historical, and contextual understanding of the Scripture.

Restoring The Torah:

Matt 5:18 ESV

¹⁸ For truly, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the Torah until all is accomplished.

Study the TaNaKh (the Torah, Nevi'im, Ketuvim) as well as the Apostolic Scriptures.

Prepare The Way For The Messiah:

John 17:17 ESV

- ¹⁷Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth.
 - Believers need to restore "the Gospel" that Yeshua and the Apostles taught.
 - While all Christians teach that Yeshua saves, it is imperative that we teach what He taught! (for Yeshua and the Apostles never broke the Father's Word, "and Scripture cannot be broken" (Matt 10:35).

Disciple Torah Observant Messianic Disciples:

Matt 7:21-23 ESV

- ²¹ "Not everyone who says to Me, 'הוה, 'הוה,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.
- ²²On that day many will say to Me, 'הוה, 'הוה, did we not prophesy in your Name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your Name?'
- ²³And then will I declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.'

Preparing the way for the Messiah can only be accomplished by obeying and walking His Words.
