What is the meaning of

“Congregation Faithful Stewardship”?

עֲדַת הַאֲרִיסִים הַנֶּאֱמָנִים:

(Adat HaArisim HaNe'amaneem)

“We are a unified body of Believers who is bearing witness while the Master *is away*.”

Meanings of individual words:

Adat (pronounced: ay-daht). עֲדַת, means ‘people with unity; bearing witness.’ (This term is in the TaNaKh/OT & in Mishnaic Hebrew)

HaArisim (ha-ah-ree-seem) הַאֲרִיסִים, means ‘in charge while the master is away.’

HaNe'amaneem (ha-nay-ah-mah-neem) הַנֶּאֱמָנִים, means ‘Believers.’
