Deuteronomy 1:1

NIV ¹ These are the words Moses spoke to all Israel in the wilderness east of the Jordan—that is, in the Arabah—opposite Suph, between Paran and Tophel, Laban, Hazeroth and Dizahab.

ESV ¹These are the words that Moses spoke to all Israel beyond the Jordan in the wilderness, in the Arabah opposite Suph, between Paran and Tophel, Laban, Hazeroth, and Dizahab. (English Standard Version)

YOUR TRANSLATION: These are the words that Moses spoke to all Israel / across (or east) of the Jordan / in the wilderness, in the Arabah / opposite Suph / between Paran, Tophel, Laban, Hazeroth, and Dizahab.
