Blessing: for Holiness & Lighting the Candles

Lighting the candles, we proclaim the distinction between the holy of YHVH's festival & the common of regular days.

“How blessed are those whose way is blameless, Who walk in the Torah [law] of YHVH [the LORD].” (Ps 119:1 NASB)

(chant the line in undertone) Baruch shem kavod malchuto layohlam va-ed

Vayahavta et YHVH elohaycha baychol layvavcha uvchol nafshaycha uvchol mayoday-cha. (repeat twice)

Ve-ahavta lere-acha kamocho. (Amen)

Hear, O Israel, YHVH Our God, YHVH is One.

Blessed be His glorious Name Whose kingdom is forever and ever!

& you shall love YHVH your God with all your heart & with all your soul & with all your might. & these words that I command you today shall be in your heart.

& you shall teach them diligently to your children, & you shall speak of them when you sit at home, & when you walk along the way, and when you lie down & when you rise up. & you shall bind them as a sign on your hand, & they shall be for frontlets between your eyes. & you shall write them on the doorposts of your house & on your gates. (Dt 6:4-9)
