**YHVH: The tetragrammaton יהוה is pronounced in various ways: Adonai, HaShem, etc. Many scholars believe, that during the time of our Messiah, this name was pronounced Yahveh.

The LORD [YHVH] make His face to shine upon you & be gracious to you; & give you peace.
