EXAMINING PRE-TRIBULATION RAPTURE

II Thes 2:1-4 ESV

- 1Now concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our being gathered together to Him, we ask you, brothers,
- 2not to be quickly shaken in mind or alarmed, either by a spirit or a spoken word, or a letter seeming to be from us, to the effect that the Day of the LORD has come.
- 3Let no one deceive you in any way. For that day will not come, unless the rebellion comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction, (man of lawlessness)
- 4who opposes and exalts himself against every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, proclaiming himself to be God.
 - 1. Yeshua is the Same Yesterday, today and forever!
 - 2. He cannot lie. It is impossible!
 - 3. Do not Add or Subtract from His Word!

<u>There is only one second coming of the LORD</u>. There are not two second comings.

Paul says: The Day of the L<u>ORD</u> and being gathered together to Him. <u>Let no one deceive you in any way</u>.

- For that day will not come unless the rebellion comes first!
- and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction, (man of lawlessness)

Matt 24:29-31

29"Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken.

- 30 Then will appear in heaven the sign of the Son of Man, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.
- 31 And he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.
 - Immediately after the tribulation
 - those days
 - will appear in heaven the sign of the Son of Man, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn
 - they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.
 - loud trumpet call
 - they will gather his elect

1 Thes 4:13-18

- 13But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers, about those who are asleep, that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope.
- 14For since we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so, through Jesus, God will bring with him those who have fallen asleep.
- 15 For this we declare to you by a word from the LORD, that we who are alive, who are left until the coming of the LORD, will not precede those who have fallen asleep.
- 16For the LORD himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.

- 17 Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the LORD in the air, and so we will always be with the LORD.
- 18 Therefore encourage one another with these words.
 - -do not want you to be uninformed
 - the <u>LORD himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command</u>, with the <u>voice of an archangel</u>, and <u>with the sound of the trumpet of God</u>.
 - <u>Then</u> we who are alive, who are left, <u>will be caught up together with</u> them in the clouds to meet the LORD in the air, and so we will always be with the LORD.

1 Corinthians 15:50-54

- <u>50</u>I tell you this, brothers: flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable.
- 51Behold! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
- 52in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed.
- 53 For this perishable body must put on the imperishable, and this mortal body must put on immortality.
- 54When the perishable puts on the imperishable, and the mortal puts on immortality, then shall come to pass the saying that is written:

at the last trumpet the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed this mortal body must put on immortality.
