

## **Zechariah's Prophecy Luke 1:68-75**

67And his father Zechariah was filled with the Holy Spirit and prophesied, saying,

68“Blessed be the Lord God of Israel,  
for he has visited and redeemed his people

69and has raised up a horn of salvation for us  
in the house of his servant David,

70as he spoke by the mouth of his holy prophets from of old,

71that we should be saved from our enemies  
and from the hand of all who hate us;

72to show the mercy promised to our fathers  
and to remember his holy covenant,

73the oath that he swore to our father Abraham, to grant us

74that we, being delivered from the hand of our enemies,  
might serve him without fear,

75in holiness and righteousness before him all our days.

**Isa 66:13-16**

**13**As one whom his mother comforts,  
so I will comfort you;  
you shall be comforted in Jerusalem.

**14**You shall see, and your heart shall rejoice;  
your bones shall flourish like the grass;  
and the hand of the LORD shall be known to his servants,  
and he shall show his indignation against his enemies.

***Final Judgment and Glory of the LORD***

**15**“For behold, the LORD will come in fire,  
and his chariots like the whirlwind,  
to render his anger in fury,  
and his rebuke with flames of fire.

**16**For by fire will the LORD enter into judgment,  
and by his sword, with all flesh;  
and those slain by the LORD shall be many.
