- 1 When reciting the Shema face East toward Jerusalem, following the Prophet Daniel's example of praying facing toward the Temple.
- 2 Yeshua declared the Shema is the greatest Commandment, Mk 12:29 & Dt 6:4.
- 3 Love your neighbor as yourself, Mk 12:30-31; Lev 19:18; Dt 6:5-9.
- 4 As YHVH told Joshua: "Be strong and of good courage" Joshua 1:6.
- 5 *Going up to the Torah* (the Torah service) is to reverence God's Holy Word.

A Bar Mitzvah is open to any individual at any age.

A CFS Bar Mitzvah includes the individual's making a 3-to-5-month rigorous commitment to the study of YHVH's Word from a Messianic viewpoint & Biblical Hebrew 101 & 102.

The individual will complete an interview with a CFS ordained minister. If the individual is less than 18 years old, their parent or guardian must attend the interview & agree to support & encourage their child in this endeavor.

Qualifications:

- Must participate in CFS services & functions.

Upon completion of Bar Mitzvah training, the individual will recognition by the Congregation & the Pastors.
