Josiah James Robeson Bar Mitzvah - 05/04/2024 YHVH's Word is Perfect-draft only 3-17-2024

Pastor Don: This Bar Mitzvah is proclaiming what Josiah believes.

Introduction:

- "I want to thank all of you for coming to my Bar Mitzvah!
- In the presence of Yeshua's body of believers, let be known that on 'This Day' (May 4) I am openly proclaiming that Yeshua (or Jesus) is 'My LORD'. And that I will obey Him in all my thoughts and actions.
- Let it be known that "I believe <u>All of YHVH's Word</u>"!
- In my confession of faith, I will be explaining my understanding of "the Gospel" according to YHVH's Word.
- My intention is to restore "Yeshua's Word" to its proper historical context. For example, I will be referring to <u>Jesus</u> by His proper name <u>Yeshua</u>. The name *Yeshua* means: *YHVH saves*.
- I am also using Yeshua's correct title <u>Messiah</u>, rather than <u>Christ</u>. Why? Because *Messiah* means *the Coming One* or *the Anointed One*.

YHVH's Word is Perfect

Psalm 19:7 in the ESV says: "The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul; the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple;"

First, I am going to talk a little about this verse. The original language for "law" is Torah in Hebrew, and LORD is YHVH.

Now, I shall re-read Psalm 19:7 with these words as given by our Savior. "The Torah of the YHVH is perfect, reviving the soul; the testimony of YHVH is sure, making wise the simple;"

This time, I shall read this verse using words that help to explain this verse: "The Torah of the YHVH is perfect, converting the soul, the ordinance of YHVH is sure, making wise the simple-minded;"

Now, I shall read this verse, Psalm 19:7, in Hebrew. The Hebrew from which I am reading is the Westminster Leningrad Codex. This is the oldest and most respected manuscript of the Torah.
