# "The Most Wicked Belief"

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Refer to the last page: "How to Interpret Scripture"

"For by your words [reflecting your spiritual condition] you will be justified and acquitted of the guilt of sin; and by your words [rejecting Me] you will be condemned and sentenced." Matthew 12:37 Amp

Your notes:

Who could deny the importance of each and every Word of the living God!?! A common fallacy that many teach is that YHVH's Words are divided into three categories: moral, civil, and ceremonial.

First, let me point out that is NOT IN THE SCRIPTURES. Secondly, no true follower of YHVH would even consider suggesting that His Words are divided into three categories. The mere fact that some man would tell the living God that he, as a mere man, knows how to divide YHVH's Words! It was YHVH who stated that His eternal absolutes are unconditional.

I am troubled when I ponder that anyone could think they, as mere men, could tell YHVH Himself that His Words need to be divided! Only the antichrist would challenge YHVH. This person is Torah-less, and they themselves are spiritually empty.

## We cannot be swayed anymore!

Let us fully grasp that YHVH's Words are living oracles. These words not only are life-giving, but they also are condemning.

Today, we are moving into another age; this era is unlike anything man has ever before encountered. People actually believe that they can say and believe whatever they can conjure up. And they coerce others to follow their evil ways. Yes, our words impact others, and how they interpret YHVH.

If you think that I am wrong, then why is it that 93% of all Christians in the United State do not believe the Bible! Yet these people are born again; and at the same time they actually believe that His Word is divided into the three categories: moral, civil, and ceremonial? This is an abomination.

### YHVH quoted Deut 4:2 in Rev 22:18-19:

"You shall not add to the word which I am commanding you, nor take away from it, so that you may keep the commandments of the LORD [YHVH] your God which I am commanding you". Deuteronomy 4:2 is quoted in Revelation 22:18-19 Amp

Don't think that you are so special that you will be excused! Yeshua loves us, but He does not need us. He is searching for those who obey Him.

Jesus answered, "If anyone [really] loves Me, he will keep My word (teaching); and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our dwelling place with him. 24 One who does not [really] love Me does not keep My words. And the word (teaching) which you hear is not Mine, but is the Father's who sent Me." John 14:23-24 Amp

# Let us judge ourselves honestly

The reality is that what we are doing today, right now, is what Yeshua will judge us for! If we need to repent, do it NOW!

Unfortunately, the majority of people with whom I speak do not grasp the depth of His Word. Why do I say that? Because they continue in the same old way they were brought up. In actuality, we all need to change – no one is perfect nor has any arrived. We all need to become like Yeshua.

Let us spend our time wisely, learning to walk in His Ways rather than telling Yeshua what is incorrect and what is good in His Word.

Forget man-made theologies! His Word is perfect, and He is perfect. Everything Yeshua does is righteous and holy; and YHVH does not change!

# "How to Interpret Scripture"

### Three things to always apply when studying Scripture:

- 1. *Contextually* study Scripture within the context of the entire Bible.
- 2. *Literally* read Scripture literally what do the words actually mean.
- 3. *Historically* understand Scripture within its historical/chronological context.

### The character of Yeshua according to His Word:

- 1. "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, & forever," [Heb 13:8; Malachi 3:6]
- 2. "God is not a man that He should lie," [Num 23:19; Heb 6:18]
- 3. Do not add or subtract from the Scriptures, [Deut 4:2; Rev 22:18-19]

### Key Scriptures to Interpret the Bible

Matt 28:18-20 – this is after His resurrection.

<sup>18</sup>And Jesus [Yeshua] came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup>Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup>teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Acts 1:6-8 – after Yeshua's resurrection, He spoke to His disciples about the restoration of Israel.

<sup>6</sup>So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord [YHVH], will you at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

### John 4:22-24 Amplified Bible

<sup>22</sup> You [Samaritans] do <sup>not</sup> know what you worship; we [Jews] do know what we worship, for salvation is from the Jews. <sup>23</sup> But a time is coming and is already here when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit [from the heart, the inner self] and in truth; for the Father seeks such people to be His worshipers. <sup>24</sup> God is spirit [the Source of life, yet invisible to mankind], and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

John 3:36 – the book of John stated that obedience is key to eternal life:

<sup>36</sup>Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

James 1:25

<sup>25</sup>But he who looks carefully into the perfect law, the *law* of liberty, and faithfully abides by it, not having become a [careless] listener who forgets but an active doer [who obeys], he will be blessed *and* favored by God in what he does [in his life of obedience].

James 2:12

<sup>12</sup>Speak and act [consistently] as people who are going to be judged by the law of liberty [that moral law that frees obedient Christians from the bondage of sin].

1John 2:3-6 - the Apostle John asked, "Do you really know God?":

<sup>3</sup>And by this we know that we have come to know him, if we keep his commandments. <sup>4</sup> Whoever says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him, <sup>5</sup> but whoever keeps his word, in him truly the love of God is perfected. By this we may know that we are in him: <sup>6</sup> whoever says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked. [Note: Yeshua perfectly kept the Torah; likewise, we also need to &, thereby, stop sinning.]

James 2:19-24

<sup>19</sup>You believe that God is one; you do well [to believe that]. The demons also believe [that], and shudder *and* bristle [in awe-filled terror--they have seen His wrath]! <sup>20</sup>But are you willing to recognize, you foolish [spiritually shallow] person, that faith without [good] works is useless? <sup>21</sup>Was our father Abraham not [shown to be] justified by works [of obedience which expressed his faith] when he offered Isaac his son on the altar [as a sacrifice to God]? <sup>22</sup>You see that [his] faith was working together with his works, and as a result of the works, his faith was completed [reaching its maturity when he expressed his faith through obedience]. <sup>23</sup>And the Scripture was fulfilled which says, "ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND THIS [faith] WAS CREDITED TO HIM [by God] AS RIGHTEOUSNESS *and* AS CONFORMITY TO HIS WILL," and he was called the friend of God. <sup>24</sup>You see that a man (believer) is justified by works and not by faith alone [that is, by acts of obedience a born-again believer reveals his faith].

John 12:47-50

47 If anyone hears My words and does not keep them, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge *and* condemn the world [that is, to initiate the final judgment of the world], but to save the world. 48 Whoever rejects Me and refuses to accept My teachings, has one who judges him; the *very* word that I spoke will judge *and* condemn him on the last day. 49 For I have never spoken on My own initiative *or* authority, but the Father Himself who sent Me has given Me a commandment *regarding* what to say and what to speak. 50 I know that His commandment is eternal life. So the things I speak, I speak [in accordance with His exact instruction,] just as the Father has told Me."
