Explanation of how to use this Calendar

- * **The dates listed** in the left column are the dates by when the readings are to be **completed**. It is interesting to note that the same Torah and Haftarah readings are done on the same day all over the world!
- * The Hebrew Bible sometimes has a different verse number than the standard Christian or English Bible. The **numbers in parentheses** are the **verse numbers used in the standard Christian or English Bible** that are different from those in the Hebrew Bible.
- * **Special readings** for the festivals. These readings are **primarily from Leviticus 23**, which lists each of the festivals. The Traditional Readings are those readings that are done in synagogues all over the world.
- * **We are appreciative of Dr. David Stern's work in his 1998 Complete Jewish Bible where he put the Apostolic Scripture readings with each of the weekly Torah readings.**
