Truth: אֵלֶת -- N-fs (Noun-feminine singular)

World: עוֹלְם -- N-ms (Noun-masculine singular)

People: 전호 -- N-ms (Noun-masculine singular)

The house: תְבַיִּת -- art; N-ms (article; Noun-masculine singular)

The land: רְאָרֶהְ -- art; N-fs (article; Noun-feminine singular)

The lands: הְאַרְצוֹת -- art; N-fp (article; Noun-feminine plural)

Mother: ロス -- N-fs (Noun-feminine singular)

The mothers: חוֹקאַמַהוֹים art; N-fp (article; Noun-feminine plural)

Father: 28 -- N-ms (Noun-masculine singular)

The fathers: הָאָבוֹת -- art; N-mp (article; Noun-masculine plural; this ending is irregular)

I or me: "!" -- pro-1cs (pronoun-1st person common [refers to either a male or a female] singular)

You masculine: תַּלְּהַ -- pro-2ms (pronoun-2nd person masculine singular)

You feminine: 78 -- pro-2fs (pronoun-2nd person feminine singular)

He: 🕅 -- pro-3ms (pronoun-3<sup>rd</sup> person masculine singular)

She: X77 (archaic or Biblical form X17)-- pro-3fs (pronoun-3<sup>rd</sup> person feminine singular)
