#### 9.01 supplement **Review dagesh kal & dagesh chazak** (review Lesson 9)

Dagesh kal (לְגֵעׁ עֵלֵּלִ) is also called dagesh lene (or a weak dagesh)

- 1. The dagesh kal is found only in the 6 BeGeD KeFeT letters (בֵּגֶד כֵּכָת)
- 2. Remember the dagesh kal does not follow a vowel. (However, it can follow a sh'va.)

#### Dagesh chazak (בְּגִע חָוָדְ שׁבָּיִן) is also called dagesh forte (or dagesh strong)

- 1. The dagesh chazak always follows a vowel.
- 2. A dagesh chazak doubles the consonant.
- 3. A dagesh chazak may appear in any consonant <u>except</u> the 5 gutturals (aleph: א, hey: ה, chet: ה, ayin: א, & sometimes resh: ה).

#### Grammar-made-simple: dagesh kal & dagesh chazak:

- 1. Dagesh kal: When a BeGeD KeFeT letter begins a word or opens a syllable, it has a dagesh kal. This dagesh changes sound only with \(\textstyle{1}\) to \(\textstyle{2}\); from \(\textstyle{2}\) to \(\textstyle{2}\); & from \(\textstyle{2}\) to \(\textstyle{2}\).

  A dagesh kal does not follow a vowel. (It can follow a sh'va.)
- 2. Dagesh chazak: May appear in any consonant except the 5 gutturals (aleph: ℵ, hey: ¬, chet: ¬, ayin: ¬, & sometimes resh: ¬).

## 9.02 supplement Review Sh'va Level 1 & Level 2 (review Lessons 8 & 9)

# Level 1: when a sh'va is at the beginning of a word, it is vocal

Word	Meaning	Transliteration The small "eh" signifies the quick & almost indistinguishable "eh" sound.

#### Level 2: when 2 sh'vas are consecutive (in other words, are in a row)

#### When 2 sh'vas are consecutive, the 1st is silent & 2nd is vocal.

- The first of two consecutive sh'vas closes the syllable. The first sh'va is silent.
   The second of 2 consecutives sh'vas is vocal *and* has a quick "eh" sound.

#### Grammar-made-simple: Levels 1 & 2 of the vocal sh'va:

- 1. Level 1: If the sh'va is under the 1<sup>st</sup> consonant of the word, it is vocal.
- 2. Level 2: If there are 2 sh'vas in a row (consecutive), the 1st is silent (it closes the syllable) & the 2<sup>nd</sup> is vocal (& it opens the syllable).

## Level 3: when a sh'va is under a dagesh chazak (דָגָשׁ חָּוָק), it is vocal. (Review Lesson 9.01)

# Grammar-made-simple: Level 3 & dagesh chazak:

- 1.Sh'va under dagesh chazak is vocal.
- 2. A <u>dagesh chazak follows a vowel any full vowel</u>. (Sh'vas, chatafs, & diphthongs are not full vowels.)

#### Level 4: when a sh'va follows a long vowel\*, it is vocal. (Review Lesson 9.01)
